**ORDINANCE NO. 0509
SERIES OF 2018**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF NORWOOD, COLORADO, AMENDING THE NORWOOD TOWN CODE CHAPTER 1, SECTION 1-4-1, "GENERAL PENALTY" AND CHAPTER 5, SECTION 5-1-8.A," TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM FINE FROM ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) TO TWO THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$2,650.00).

WHEREAS, the Town Board of Trustees has determined that increasing the maximum fine for conviction of offenses in the Town of Norwood, consistent with Colorado Revised Statutes section 31-16-101, is in the public health, safety and interest of the Town of Norwood.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF NORWOOD, COLORADO as follows:

Section One.

The Norwood Town Code Section 1-4-1, "General Penalty" shall be amended to read as follows:

1-4-1: GENERAL PENALTY: Any person convicted of a violation of any section or provision of this Town Code, where no other penalty is set forth, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed two thousand six hundred fifty dollars (\$2,650.00) or by imprisonment not to exceed ninety (90) days for any one offense, or by both such fine and imprisonment.¹

Section Two.

The Norwood Town Code Section 5-1-8.A, "General Penalty Provisions [Offenses]" shall be amended to read as follows:

5-1-8: GENERAL PENALTY PROVISIONS:

A. General Penalty: Any person convicted for a violation of any section or subsection of the Offenses Code, unless it is specifically provided otherwise therein, shall be subject to punishment by a fine not to exceed two thousand six hundred fifty dollars (\$2,650.00), imprisonment for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days, or both such fine and imprisonment.⁸

Section Three.

The provisions of this ordinance are severable and the invalidity of any section, phrase, clause or portion of the ordinance as determined by a court of competent jurisdiction shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remainder of the ordinance.


Section Four.

This ordinance shall not have any effect on existing litigation and shall not operate as an abatement of any action or proceeding now pending under or by virtue of the ordinances repealed or amended as herein provided and the same shall be construed and concluded under such prior ordinances.

Section Five.


The effective date of this Ordinance shall be May 9, 2018 at the time of its adoption.
