I. PROCEDURE

- A. Customer shall submit a completed Application for Sewer Service, together with an engineering feasibility study, a \$50 Application Fee payable to the "Norwood Sanitation District," and a \$500 Deposit for Engineer's Review.
- B. The Applicant is responsible for reimbursing the Sanitation District for the Actual cost of review of the feasibility study by the District's engineer. If the cost is less than \$500, any balance of the deposit for engineer's review shall be refunded to the applicant. If the cost is more than the \$500 deposit, the deposit will be applied against the cost of engineering review and the applicant shall be responsible for the additional cost.
- C. As soon as possible, the District's engineer and the (Superintendent) will complete a review of the proposed sewer line extension and make a determination of service feasibility consistent with the Sanitation District's rules & regulations.
- D. Upon a determination that the requested service is feasible, a customer shall submit a Sewer service contract, in a form provided by the Sanitation District and pay the applicable Plant Investment Fee(s).
- E. The plant investment fee does not include the cost of the acquisition of easement(s), materials, or the installation of sewer main(s), collection line(s), service line(s) or first year's maintenance of main and/or collection line(s).
